### PACT Folders / Homework

You can help your child by listening to them read regularly and by ensuring they can read and spell the Year 1 or 2 Common Exception words. We encourage regular use of the Mathletics website on computer or tablet (A login will be sent home in the next few weeks). You could also visit the library to look at books to extend your child's learning. We will soon start to send home fortnightly Sounds-Write homework on a Monday which is based on your child's learning the previous week. This will need to be returned completed on the following Friday. We will also start to send home the Dandelion 'Sounds-Write' books for most of the children as we have been doing all term. It is very important that the children read these at least 3 times a week at home as they need to be fluent before moving on. We really appreciate your support with this. These books are more important than the book banded books so please prioritise these to read if you only have time for one.
