#### PACT Folders / Homework

You can help your child by listening to them read regularly and by ensuring they can read and spell the Year 1 or 2 Common Exception words. We encourage regular use of the Mathletics website on computer or tablet (A login will be sent home this week). You could also visit the library to look at books to extend your child's learning. We will continue to send home fortnightly Sounds-Write homework based on your child's learning the previous week. This will be sent out on a Monday on a Monday and will need to be returned completed on the following Friday. The Dandelion 'Sounds-Write' books will also continue to be sent home and it is very important that the children read these at least 3 times a week as they need to be fluent before moving on. Please record in their yellow Reading Record each time you hear them read. We really appreciate your support with this. These books are more important than the book banded books so please prioritise these to read if you only have time for one.
