This week we went on a walk around Trowbridge looking for significant features. The children were fantastic and found lots! When back at school we talked about what we had found and where we had walked. We then placed photos of these features on a large map. After that the children all had a go at drawing their own maps of the walk. In Maths, we have been developing our understanding of measure and using the language to compare for example shorter than, taller than, longer than. In Sounds write we are continuing to consolidate our learning. We are really focussing on the digraphs (2 letters, 1 sound) and blending to read words with 5 sounds. We have had a super busy term and are all ready for a break. We hope the sun continues to shine for you all over half term!
