Our learning this week ...

Wren & Robin

This week we have been 'monkeying' around! We have enjoyed listening to the story Monkey Puzzle by Julia Donaldson and learning all about monkeys from non-fiction books. In maths, we have been recapping number patterns focussing on doubles and odd and even numbers. The children have been inventing their own verses for the song 'Daddy's taking us to the zoo tomorrow'. I wonder if they can sing it too you! We have also been continuing to learn our country dance for the Summer Fayre.

In Year 1/2 this week we have been focusing on writing character and setting descriptions using expanded noun phrases. The children have really impressed us with their choice of powerful adjectives! In Science, we have been exploring nutrition and what this means for living things. We looked at the diets of different animals to understand what a Carnivore, Herbivore and an Omnivore is. Finally, we used our knowledge to create food chains, recognising that each food chain begins with a Producer – a Living thing that creates its own food source.

This week in year 3/4 we have had a fun packed week. On Monday, we were lucky to have Mrs Sager join us for some French sessions. The children were really engaged. They were learning about the very important topic of ice creams! It was amazing to see the children's understanding and knowledge on display in the session. In Maths, we have been doing a number of different topics, in one group the focus was shape and in another it was money. We came together on Thursday to practice for Sports day, and some great performances were seen in the races, the children are looking forward to showing what they can do on the day!

Osprey, Falcon & Kestrel

In Year 5/6 this week, we have been continuing our learning about Greek Myths. We have looked at the myth, Theseus and the Minotaur, where the mighty Theseus must escape the labyrinth where the terrifying minotaur is lurking. The children have looked at different versions of this story and compared them, looking at key details and levels of description. In our History learning, the children have been looking at the two city-states of Sparta and Athens. They have looked at the very different ways in which both of these states where run during Ancient Greek times. We have also been looking at the Ancient Greek Olympics and learning some key facts about how these are different to today's Olympics. Did you know the competitors used to do their events naked? In our production of Aladdin this week, the children have been able to perform the play mostly off script, meaning the acting is coming to life even more! We had a successful cake sale this week to raise money for our production. Thank you to everyone who provided or bought cake!
