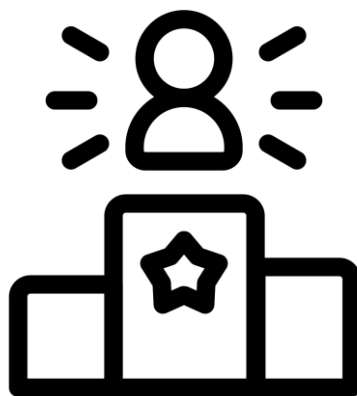


Pick and Mix Home Learning

Alongside our usual homework expectations around daily reading, spellings practice and learning number facts (number bonds and times tables), we would also like to encourage the children to engage with our wider topic at home. These activities are completely optional and are intended as an opportunity for the children to explore our school curriculum creatively. On the last Monday of term (Oct 16th), we would encourage the children to bring any pick and mix home learning they have done or photos of some of the things that they have been up to into school to share with the class.



Year 3/4 - Autumn 1 - Trailblazers

Create a Trailblazer Timeline:
Encourage children to research famous trailblazers who have made a significant impact on society. They can create a timeline using pictures and dates to show the key moments in their life and achievements.

Create an award:
Children could create an award that they would gift to a Trailblazer. This could be a medal, a trophy or any other idea they can think of!

Create a Trailblazer Collage:
Children can create a collage of inspirational figures who have made a positive impact on society. They can use pictures from magazines or printouts from online sources to create a visual representation of their chosen trailblazers.

Write a letter:
The children could write a letter to a Trailblazer of their own choice and tell them why they think they are inspiring! They could add drawings or decorate their page.

Represent the cause:
Pick a trailblazer and make a poster to show you support them
E.G - Rosa Park and a poster to boycott the buses.

News report:
Write or film a report about the amazing work your Trailblazer has done!
