

## Y3/4 Homework Project – Term 3 and 4 - Due in WB March 6<sup>th</sup> 2023

As you know our History based topic work for this term, and next, is centred on Invaders, focusing on Celts, Anglo Saxons and Vikings. To support learning, we would like the children to complete a homework project of their choice. There are example ideas listed below, or you can choose something of your own to do based on the invaders mentioned. **We would like each child to complete at least one piece of work. Finished projects to be handed in during the week beginning March 6<sup>th</sup>.** After that date, we will display the children's finished projects for parents/carers to come and view (date to be confirmed).

- Research Celtic or Anglo Saxon homes and build a model of a Celtic roundhouse or an Anglo Saxon House.



- Look at examples of Celtic or Anglo Saxon patterns and create some of your own.



- Write a fact file about Boudica, leader of the Iceni tribe.
- Imagine you are a Celtic/Anglo Saxon/Viking warrior. Write a diary entry of a day in your life.
- Research Viking Longships and make a model of a Longship.



- Dress a doll/teddy/cardboard cut-out in Celtic/Anglo Saxon/Viking clothes.
- Create, and decorate, a time line to show the order in which the invaders came to Britain - you could include the Romans on it too.
- Find out and write a fact file about an aspect of Celtic/Anglo Saxon/Viking life eg homes, food, clothing, weapons, etc.
- Compare and contrast an aspect of life for the Celts/Anglo Saxons/Vikings.
- Make a Celtic/Anglo Saxon/Viking shield.



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- Make a model of a Celtic hillfort.
- Write a fact file about Alfred the Great, an Anglo Saxon King.
- Create a map of the journeys The Angles, The Saxons and The Jutes took to get to Britain. Maybe you could make this into a board game?
- Design and make a piece of Anglo Saxon style jewellery - <https://www.imagininghistory.co.uk/post/make-an-anglo-saxon-brooch>
- Research Celtic/Anglo Saxon/Viking food. Plan a meal or menu.
- Research the Viking alphabet and try to write something using it.
