BRITISH VALUES

The DfE have reinforced the need "to create and enforce a clear and rigorous expectation on all schools to promote the fundamental British values of democracy, the rule of law, individual liberty and mutual respect and tolerance of those with different faiths and beliefs."

At Paxcroft Primary School we uphold and teach pupils about British Values which are defined as:

democracy;

rule of law;

individual liberty ;

mutual respect ;

tolerance of those of different faiths and beliefs.

These values are taught explicitly through Personal, Social, Health and Emotional (PSHE), and Religious Education (RE). We also teach British Values through planning and delivering a broad and balanced curriculum.

At Paxcroft Primary School, we value the diverse ethnic backgrounds of all pupils and families and undertake a variety of events and lessons to celebrate these. We have found this approach to be enriching for all parties as it teaches tolerance and respect for the differences in our community and the wider world.

At Paxcroft Primary School we would actively challenge pupils, staff or parents expressing opinions contrary to fundamental British Values, including 'extremist' views.

At Paxcroft these values are reinforced regularly and in the following ways:

RULE OF LAW
