Our Learning this week ...

Owls

This week in Literacy we have been continuing to look at the story 'Lulu's Nana Visits'. We have been discussing the similarities and differences between two of the characters. We have also talked about giving and receiving gifts. The children then made a bracelet to give to a friend as a gift. In Maths, we have been looking at repeating patterns and being able to recognise and name 2D shapes. We printed repeating patterns with shapes as well as made them with our toys. In PE, we started our Jasmine Scheme where we pretended to ride around on bikes. We were very impressed with how quickly and independently the children got changed into their PE kits. We are still working on getting back into our uniform!



Woodpecker, Kingfisher & Nightingale

It's been another busy week for KS1! In Maths, we have been ordering and comparing numbers up to 20, as well as working with number lines. In English, the children have continued to explore *The Secret of the Black Rock*, while developing the skill of writing a diary from the perspective of the main characters. In History, KS1 have been learning all about famous explorers. They've discovered the achievements of Neil Armstrong, the first man to walk on the moon, and Robert Falcon Scott's adventurous journey to the South Pole.

Skylark, Housemartin & Swift

Oh the things we learn in Year 3/4! In Science, all classes have now completed the 'Poo experiment' – your children can tell you more! In Maths we are coming to the end of the unit on Place Value and will, next week, begin work on

addition and subtraction. In English, we have been making predictions based on the pictures in the story book and exploring different ways to resolve conflict. We have also sketched out what the next illustrations might look like. In Art, we have been painting in 3D using different shades of the same colour and in topic we have been continuing our learning about our Active Planet and the famous volcanic eruption near Pompeii.

Kestrel, Falcon & Osprey

This week in Year 5/6 we have been continuing to analyse the story of Corey's Rock, by channelling Isla (our main character) and writing detailed diaries of her life so far. In Maths, we have finished off our place value unit after looking at number lines to 10 million, counting through zero and negative numbers. We look forward to starting our addition and subtraction unit next week. In Science this week, we have been learning about air resistance and gravity and we are looking forward to our egg-citing, egg parachute experiment next week. Finally in Music the children have been appraising songs, identifying the instruments and learning to sing Living on a prayer


